AIDC aims to establish its corporate image as an implementer of corporate social responsibility in its business strategy. The results for the fulfillment of corporate social responsibilities are described below:


Prevention of Natural Disasters

Taiwan is located on the main path of typhoons in Northwest Pacific. The frequency of extreme weather events has increased in recent years due to climate and environmental changes. In response to such phenomena, AIDC upholds the ideals of resource integration and sharing and made use of the Company's core resources for aerospace engineering in the "Typhoon Observation Project and Southwest Monsoon Heavy Rain Observation" to contribute to the national disaster reduction and relief policy. The two programs are described below:

Typhoon Observation Project

Social Care

The project consists mainly of observation of typhoons that may affect Taiwan. The aircraft responsible for implementing the project took off from Taichung Ching Chuan Kang Air Base and reached the top of the typhoon clouds in the atmosphere and used dropwindsondes on designated flight paths to obtain information on the atmosphere. It used satellite equipment to deliver the information to the Central Weather Bureau's system. Once the data are assimilated and analyzed, they can be used to increase the accuracy for typhoon path predictions and reduce the losses from typhoons. The data are also provided to international meteorologists and academic institutions to increase the international standing of Taiwan in typhoon research.



Southwest Monsoon Heavy Rain Observation

AIDC cooperated with the Central Weather Bureau in the "Southwest Monsoon Heavy Rain Observation". Dropwindsondes were also dropped from high altitudes by an aircraft to obtain information on the atmosphere. The overall objective is to enhance early warning for heavy rain and meet disaster reduction and relief requirements. It enhances the basic scientific understanding of heavy rainfall systems caused by the Southwest Monsoon, and improves the accuracy of existing short-term quantitative rainfall estimates and forecasts. It also provides insight on the thermodynamic characteristics of the Southwest Monsoon, the mechanisms for triggering heavy rainfall systems, and the cloud microphysics and cloud dynamic structure within the mesoscale convective complex itself. The experiment also includes high-resolution quantitative rainfall forecast data simulation and radar data assimilation experiments to improve the accuracy of existing quantitative rainfall forecasts.

Implementation results

AIDC carried out two typhoon observation missions for Chanthu and Kompasu in 2021. We have carried out 85 flights for observing 69 typhoons in the "Typhoon Observation Project" as of the end of 2021 since the first flight for Typhoon Dujuan in 2003. AIDC completed 427 hours of typhoon flight observation and the results were used as major benchmarks for future flight observation projects in Taiwan and other countries. It also helps increase the accuracy for predicting the paths of typhoons that affect Taiwan. The actual typhoon path forecasts of the Central Weather Bureau show that the data from the dropwindsondes reduced the inaccuracy of typhoon path forecasts within 72 hours by approximately 6.2%. It increases the government's effectiveness in disaster prevention measures and significantly reduces the loss of life and property of people.

The "Southwest monsoon Heavy Rain Observation" was carried out from May 2006 to June 2012. The results helped researchers understand the causes of the Southwest Monsoon and helped facilitate more effective measures for disaster prevention and early warning.

Airborne Medical and Rescue Services

To make the most of the Company's resources and to help people, the Company obtained the permission from the Civil Aeronautics Administration for operating emergency medical care flights in May 2013. The Company signed the "emergency medical care flight" contract with Tung's Taichung MetroHarbor Hospital in August of the same year. AIDC also expanded the partnership with medical service teams such as Inter Partner Assistance, Chang Bing Show Chwan Memorial Hospital, and International SOS in Hong Kong (ISOS, renamed International SOS (Taiwan) Company Limited) in 2014. AIDC expanded the partnership with Executive Aviation Global Services in 2015. The Company expanded cooperation with Taiwan International Tourism and Rescue Service Association and the Medical Center of Taiwan Landseed Hospital at Taiwan Taoyuan International Airport in 2019 to provide emergency medical aircraft transportation services to help transport foreign nationals residing in Taiwan back home for treatment.

The scope of services for emergency medical flights includes Southeast Asia, Northeast Asia, and China. Flights to destinations at greater distances include Hokkaido, Ulaanbaatar, Chengdu, Bangkok, and Jakarta. The Company completed 129 missions to airports in 44 cities in Mainland China (including Hong Kong/Macau), Japan, South Korea, Cambodia, Thailand, Vietnam, and Malaysia from June 2013 to 2021.



Despite the rampage of the COVID-19 pandemic from 2020 to 2021 which reduced the number of international emergency medical care flights due to lockdown restrictions in different countries, the Company still completed the "AIDC Emergency Medical Care Flight Crew Epidemic Prevention and Health Management Plan" and reported the Plan to the Civil Aeronautics Administration. We aim to complete international emergency medical care tasks while ensuring epidemic prevention.
